In accordance with the Washington Township Zoning Ordinance, Residential Section 4.3 Para. b. and Commercial Section 5.3 Para. b. the following conditions *may* constitute blight:

“The front yards shall be maintained across the entire width of the lot except for that space occupied by permitted accessory buildings. Yards shall not be used for the storage of materials, rubbish, junk, or debris, but may be used for gardening or planting.”

The Washington Township Zoning Ordinance defines “junk” as “*any worn out, previously used, dilapidated, discarded materials, including but not necessarily limited to, scrap metal, inoperable motor vehicles and parts, construction material, household wastes including garbage, discarded appliances, and yard debris.*”
